To facilitate this need, Boston diocese has partnered with a rapid communication system called IRIS-Immediate Response Information System. This system will deliver emergency messages to parents individually by the communication method(s) of your personal choosing. In addition, Holy Name Parish School may use the IRIS system to keep you up to date on important school wide information or changes relating to groups in which your child participates.
